

## Sr. Margaret McCabe, DW, Advocates Celebrate President's Immigration Reform Order

In early December 2014 immigration advocates including Virginia Organizing, a group that has met monthly for nearly two years to advocate for immigration reform, celebrated President Barack Obama's executive order giving three-year reprieves from deportation to parents who have lived illegally in the U.S. for five or more years, and have children who are citizens or residents. Additionally, he broadened a directive that grants temporary residency status to immigrants who came illegally as children. Now, the groups will continue to rally for further



reform calling on Congress to pass legislation similar to Obama's orders, and for further legislation that would legalize another 6 million to 7 million immigrants in the U.S. illegally.

Sr. Margaret McCabe, DW, whose ministry includes working with the various grass-roots groups including Virginia Organizing, was present at the rally on Dec. 1, 2014 in Virginia to celebrate the President's executive order. Click the link
