

Sr. Evelyn Lamoureux, DW Honored with Pax Christi Metro New York Peacemaker Award

Sr. Evelyn Lamoureux, DW shares a place on the list of honorees of the Pax Christi Metro New York Peacemaker Awards along with the late Fr. Daniel Berrigan, SJ (91). Likened to St. Josephine Bakhita she was named a "doorkeeper," welcoming those who seek help and support as the Human Services coordinator at St. Boniface Roman Catholic Church in Elmont, NY; and for her tireless service on local boards including Gateway Youth Outreach; Long Island Congregations, Associations, and Neighborhoods; Long Island Federally Qualified Health Centers; Zonta Club of Long Island; Martin De Porres School and the Coalition of Religious Congregations to Stop Human Trafficking.

Honorees are those whose efforts, vision, and spirit lead the way to peace. She was recognized this year with the Christine Mulready Peacemaker Award, an award presented to a person of faith whose work for peace and justice serves to transform metropolitan New York into a community of peacemakers and justice seekers. Sr. Christine Mulready was a founding member of Pax Christi Queens and the Sisters of St. Joseph Nonviolence group. Sr. Evelyn was named the Provincial Vicker of the Daughters of Wisdom, USA Province, Islip, NY in 2014.
