

Sunroom and Wires Dedicated at Sound Beach



The Sisters of Sound Beach have a newly furnished sunroom and a rewired and updated computer system thanks to a generous bequest made by Agnes and Bill Regan in memory of Daughter of Wisdom, Sr. Jean Schaefer. Sr. Jean was Agnes' sister. Long-time family friend, attorney Marie Crook attended to unveil two plaques that will forever hang on the walls of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Convent in recognition of these gifts.

The official dedication began with thanksgiving and prayer led by Canonical Treasurer, Sr. Evelyn Eckhardt, DW, who remembered Sr. Jean for over 30 years of ministry where she served as Provincial of the vice province of Malawi, in formation, and as an educator of Sisters who would later go on to lead the province; and in later years, back in the United States as an advocate among the fields of migrant workers in South Carolina. Recalled as one with a bright and easy smile, Sr. Jean will long be remembered in the beautiful furnishings and natural light given in the sunroom of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Convent which was officially dedicated in memory of benefactors Agnes and Bill Regan. The area outside the computer room (and closet that houses the wiring) is the area officially dedicated in Sr. Jean's name.
